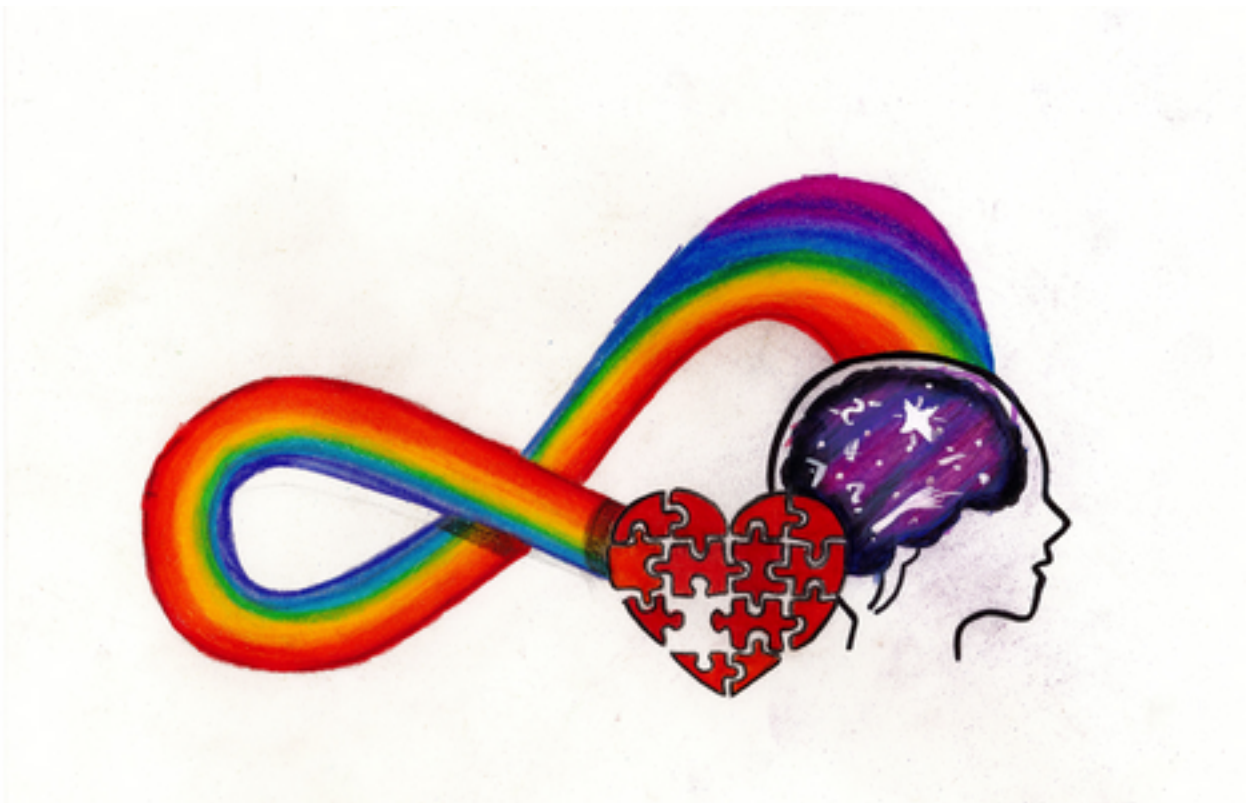


Announcing the Winners of HarrysButtons Neurodiverse Affirming Art Content
